

Week 3: A Two-Minded Master

PRAYER TIME

THIS IS YOUR DAILY SCRIPTURE:

Yours, Lord, is the greatness and the power and the glory and the splendor and the majesty, for everything in the heavens and on earth belongs to you. Yours, Lord, is the kingdom, and you are exalted as head over all (1 Chron. 29:11).

THIS IS YOUR DAILY PRAYER:

The greatness of everything belongs to You, God. The power of everything on earth and heaven belongs to You. The glory of all things in Yours, God. All of the splendor and majesty is Yours, God. This is all Your kingdom, God. I will exalt You as head over all. Remind me of this when I desire these things for myself.

DRIVE TIME

CONVERSATION

PARENT PRE-READING: *I am the Lord. That is my name, and I will not give my glory to another or my praise to idols (Isa. 42:8).*

CONVERSATION STARTER: I was reading in Isaiah 42, and it says that God will not give His glory to another. God does not want us to worship other things. Do you think that is actually a very loving thing for us? Why or why not?

STARTING QUESTIONS

When was a time in your life that you felt like you were juggling too many things in your life? What was that like?

READ THIS TOGETHER *No one can serve two masters, since either he will hate one and love the other, or he will be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and money (Matt. 6:24).*

SCRIPTURAL APPLICATION QUESTIONS

This passage talks about serving God and money. Do you think this could be true for God and other things like sports, work, or status? What are other things that we might try to give worship to?

What do you think is the big warning for us in a verse like this for our life?

When it comes to God and money, what are some ways that someone can use money or passions in their life to serve Him and not ourselves?
