The week leading to the holiday were filled with various riots across the city which included some casualties. Additionally, many Sierra Leoneans have been celebrating Ramadan, a Muslim, 30-day season of fasting. The city has been more quiet during the day, but the nights have been full of crowds as fasts are broken at sunset. This has been a stark reminder to us of the need to saturate Sierra Leone with the Gospel.

Our family is continuing to lead and serve at New Beginning Baptist Church--Babadorie. We have begun a weekly meeting with the current Sunday school teachers to assist with lesson preparation, but are also using this time to grow these men and women as spiritual leaders within the church.
