## The King and His People Discussion/Study Guide for The Birth of the Church

- Read Acts 2:1-4. In what ways did the Holy Spirit manifest Himself to the disciples in the room in which they were gathered? What did these different manifestations symbolize?
- What is the essential ingredient that seems to be transferrable and experienced in other believers throughout Acts?
- In your own words what would you say it means to be filled with the Holy Spirit? What passages of Scripture would you use to support your answer?
- What was the result of the Holy Spirit's empowering the disciples to speak in different languages? Why is this significant?
- According to Acts 2:36, what did Peter want those who heard him to come to know for certain?
- According to Acts 2:38-41, what was Peter's response to the peoples' question of what they should do? Why are repentance and baptism an important response to the gospel?
- What is promised to those who repent and are baptized in the name of Jesus?
- What are the characteristics of the new community described in Acts 2:42-47? How do these help us in assessing the Spirit's filling in our own church?
