Greetings, church family! Once again it is time to get ready for our summer Youth Camp at Camp Sinawa, Valders, WI. Junior Campers are those entering the 5<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grades. Senior Campers are those entering 9<sup>th</sup> grade and higher. Campers may bring friends.

The motto of the Camp is "DUO" which stands for "Do Unto Others". As Christians, we treat each other out of a love for one another, flowing from a love for God.

Our camp is sponsored by the Covenant East Classis of the Reformed Church in the United States and the Salem Ebenezer congregation located in Manitowoc on Highway 'C' about seven miles from camp.
