Introduction: Memorial Day, Monday, May 31, 2021

Memorial Day is a U.S. national holiday held to honor those who died while serving in the military. The word memorial is a noun that means “something designed to preserve the memory of a person, event, etc., as a monument or a holiday.” It’s also an adjective, meaning “preserving the memory of a person or thing; commemorative.”

1. Consider this definition of “memorial” and discuss how it applies to the Passover and the Lord’s Supper.
2. What were children to be told about the meaning of the Passover according to Ex. 12?
3. The Passover is to be kept as an everlasting observance. Discuss how the Lord’s Supper is a continuation of the Passover observance.
4. Compare the Observance of the Passover to the Lord’s Supper. How are they similar and different?

The Observance of Passover

Exodus 12-13

1. Commitment – To Holiness (Removal of Leaven)
2. Thanksgiving – For God’s Deliverance
3. Unity – In Participation by God’s People
4. Remembrance – The Saving Sacrifice
5. Covenant – Relationship with God

(Mat. 26; Luke 22; 1 Cor. 5:6-8; 10:17-17; 11:23-26)

1. Commitment – To Holiness (Unleavened)
 2. Thanksgiving – For God’s Deliverance
 3. Unity – In Participation by God’s People
 4. Remembrance – The Saving Sacrifice
