LESSONS FROM FIRST SAMUEL

1 Samuel 4:1-4, 10-11 “Now the Israelites went out to fight against the Philistines... ²The Philistines deployed their forces to meet Israel, and as the battle spread, **Israel was defeated by the Philistines, who killed about four thousand of them** on the battlefield. ³When the soldiers returned to camp, the elders of Israel asked, “Why did the Lord bring defeat on us today before the Philistines? Let us bring the ark of the Lord’s covenant from Shiloh, so that he may go with us and save us from the hand of our enemies. ⁴So the people sent men to Shiloh, and they brought back the ark of the covenant of the Lord Almighty, who is enthroned between the cherubim. And Eli’s two sons, Hophni and Phinehas, were there with the ark of the covenant of God. ¹⁰So the Philistines fought, and the Israelites were defeated and every man fled to his tent. The slaughter was very great; **Israel lost thirty thousand foot soldiers.** ¹¹**The ark of God was captured, and Eli’s two sons, Hophni and Phinehas, died.**”

LESSONS FOR US:

- We need to do more than just believe in God.
 - The demons believe, but they’re not going to Heaven. James 2:19 “You believe that there is one God. Good! Even the demons believe that—and shudder.”
 - Not everyone who calls Jesus “Lord” is going to Heaven. Matthew 7:21 “Not everyone who says to me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ will enter the kingdom of heaven, but **only the one who does the will of my Father** who is in heaven.”
 - We must obey the Father’s will or we are deceiving ourselves. James 1:22 “Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. **Do what it says.**”
 - Hophni and Phinehas didn’t obey God. 1 Samuel 2:17 “This sin of Hophni and Phinehas was very great in the Lord’s sight, for they were treating the Lord’s offering with contempt.”
