**Morning Worship Sermon Outline**

Text: Titus 1:5-9; I Timothy 2:8-3:2

Title: Let Christ's Church Hear His Voice

Introduction

- I. The great importance that we take to heart what God says about those men who are to be Pastors, Elders, Deacons – leaders in Christ's Church.
- II. How does the Apostle press us to take to heart the Spirit's Words?
  - A. To ignore the requirements the Lord has set out for all ordained in His Church is rebellion against Christ and His authority.
  - B. If pastors, elders, deacons do not have these qualities then it will be impossible for them to carry out the responsibilities of their office.
  - C. If the congregation chooses men who are not qualified then it will make it difficult if not impossible for them to honor those who are in office as they are instructed in Scripture.
  - D. If the congregation does not follow these qualifications they put their own souls and those of the children in danger.
  - E. God's blessing flows in the path of faith and obedience, not in turning from His directives.
- III. What are the implications of the Lord's directive for us?
