## A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

This week we continue in our first series together "First Things First." To recap where we've been: In week one, we looked at the "Disciples Model Prayer" found in Matthew 6. The prayer that Jesus taught the disciples. We prayed together as a congregation that day and then throughout the week. As a church family we say: Prayer doesn't just fuel the ministry; prayer is the ministry. Prayer was and is our first foot forward together.

In our second week we took a deeper look into "The Gospel," what it is and why it's Good News. During our time together we walked through several categories that help us make sense of the world, its history and God's place for us in it. Categories like "God's Design" – God made everything and has a plan for how everything should be, and it is perfect; "Brokenness" – the place we find ourselves anytime we do something outside of God's Design; and "The Gospel" – the good news that God sent His son Jesus to save us from Brokenness by paying for our sins and providing a way back into God's Design.

Today we enter into our third week together as a church family and will focus our attention on what Jesus says is God's Greatest Commandment.
