Ministry Updates

Serve Asia (SA)

Continuing the "Investing and Journeying" theme, let me tell you about BL. I first met him and his team during our Pre-Field Training in summer 2010. BL was a Mission Mentor leading a team of 9 to Thailand, reaching out to poor communities in Bangkok. At the end of the trip, instead of the usual 1-hour debriefing, I spent 3 hours with him. After that our Follow-up Team met with him beyond the required 6 months. Even though he graduated with a business degree, he became a youth pastor. Our SA team kept investing and journeying with him.


In 2015, BL joined our SA team and became one of SA Follow-Up team members because he believes in what SA does. Currently BL is our OMF Advocacy Director, leading Advocacy team representing OMF at different colleges and mission events.

Thank you for praying for the "Missions & Singleness" webinar; it went well, even beyond our expectations. We had over 120 registered and 67 showed up for the webinar. Some of those registered already informed us that they wouldn't be able to make it due to timing but wanted to watch the recordings. Attendees were not only from US but also from Canada, UK, Australia, Chile, Taiwan, Malaysia and Philippines. (One of the advantages of virtual over live events!)

As a Discipleship Program, we don't want to do a webinar and then that's it. We want to journey with people. We told the attendees that there will be Singleness Discussion Group as a follow-up. I expected not more than 5 to sign up for this. PTL there are 28 people who signed up from US, UK, Canada, Philippines & Malaysia. I have 4 Facilitators from US & Canada to lead these discussion groups. Please pray for 1 more facilitator to lead discussion group for those from the Philippines and Malaysia.

My team is also getting ready for another webinar "Missions and Suffering" (Details below). Please pray for all logistic details and follow up plans.
