- **Christianity is one of the only major religions that has *moved around* throughout its existence**
Other major religions have certainly multiplied and migrated, but if you look at the maps today, their global centers are more or less in the same regions in which they began. When you look at global Christianity, the center is regularly moving: from Jerusalem, to Rome, to Europe, to North America, to the “global south” (Africa, Asia, Latin America)

Four Insights for Witnessing from Acts 1-7

- 1) Witnessing is about letting go of your life
- 2) Witnessing is for *everyone* and about *everything* we do
- 3) Witnessing is not about forcing the moment, but being ready when the moment comes
- 4) Witnessing is not just sharing ideas, but sharing something we've actually experienced
