

A Prayer for the God-exalting Blessing of Unity by Scotty Smith

It's *clearly* obvious that where believers dwell in unity you bestow your presence and blessing. For unity is a revelation of life within the Godhead—the eternal life into we have been called, birthed and secured. It's *equally* obvious that where there's disunity, Satan bestows his darkness and evil; suspicion and distrust; cynicism and gossip; disintegration and separation. God have mercy on all of us...

Boldly and shamelessly, we ask you for a fresh outpouring of your Spirit on our churches—a downpour of humility, repentance and healing; a deluge of the sane-making power of your presence. Jesus, drench us with the humbling and unifying dew of the gospel. We want to be sopping wet, not merely damp. Saturate and satiate us with the fullness of the Holy Spirit.

We don't look to Aaron and his beard, but to you and your enthronement at the right hand of the Father. Jesus, you are our great High Priest who has received the Spirit without measure, so you can pour forth the Spirit without reservation. Do so without delay, we ask, for the glory of God and the fame of your Name.

As we think of our church families, we also pray for new church plants in their infancy and older church families needing renewal; for missionary teams under fire and in duress; for para-church ministries—even whole denominations. Jesus, bring the grace and truth of the gospel to bear in observable, unmistakable and transforming ways.

No one has done more to secure our unity than you, Lord Jesus (<u>Eph. 2:14-22</u>). No one is praying more for our unity than you (<u>John 17:20-21</u>). No one is more glorified by our unity than you (<u>John 17:22-26</u>). Continue to heal us, reconcile us, and deploy us into your ripened harvest and broken creation together. So very Amen we pray, in your glorious and gracious name.

3. Christ Desires Heaven for His Church

John 17:24 (ESV)

²⁴Father, I desire that they also, whom you have given me, may be with me where I am, to see my glory that you have given me because you loved me before the foundation of the world.

4. Christ Makes a Final Vow to the Church

John 17:25-26 (ESV)

O righteous Father, even though the world does not know you, I know you, and these know that you have sent me. ²⁶I made known to them your name, and I will continue to make it known, that the love with which you have loved me may be in them, and I in them."

Conclusion

Jesus promises to continue the work of making the Father's name known. This promise is our hope, and our abiding in Christ is maintained and strengthened through continually growing in understanding the Father through His Word. The more we know the Father, the greater our faith will be, and the greater our obedience to the Father will be. Jesus' death and resurrection was the greatest revelation of the Father's love and right-eousness. Once Jesus returned to the Father, He continues revealing the Father to us, so we are not abandoned in our mission.

India is the nation with the LARGEST number of unreached people groups. Many of these do not have a Bible in their language. There are very few churches. As an unreached people group, it has less than 2% of Evangelical followers of



Christ. One new Indian people group we are praying to reach is the Odia people. They live in Odisha state, where 44 million souls reside. Ninety-four percent are Hindu, and 2.3% are Muslim. Our plan, with your help, is to translate our curricula into the Odia language and equip Bible-believing Christians to reach the rest of the state.

Message

One JOHN 17:20–26

Summary Statement

Jesus is poised between the conclusion of his earthly task and the glory awaiting him at the Father's side. From there he gazes out across the rolling centuries where He beholds and embraces the harvest of the ages, the church of the Redeemer, gathered from every nation, people, language and tribe. He is praying for us and in so doing He prays three things: He prays first that the church may be *united*. Secondly, he prays that the unity of the church would be a tangible one, which will cause the world to believe that Jesus was sent by the Father and that the Father loves the church. And thirdly Jesus prays for an evangelistic witness that such that the world may believe in Him through the message we bring.

1. Christ Prays for us Church on Earth

John 17:20-21 (ESV)

"I do not ask for these only, but also for those who will believe in me through their word, ²¹that they may all be one, just as you, Father, are in me, and I in you, that they also may be in us, so that the world may believe that you have sent me.

2. Christ Implements Unity on Earth

John 17:22-23 (ESV)

The glory that you have given me I have given to them, that they may be one even as we are one, ²³I in them and you in me, that they may become perfectly one, so that the world may know that you sent me and loved them even as you loved me.
