Celebration of The Lord's Supper

The Institution Luke 13:29, 24:30-31

Leader: Friends, this is the joyful feast of the people of God! People will come from east and west, from north and south, and sit at his table in the kingdom of God. When our risen Lord was at the table with his disciples, he took the bread, and blessed and broke it, and gave it them. Then their eyes were opened and they recognized them. This is the Lord's table.

People: Our Savior invites those who trust him to the feast he has prepared.

The Teaching

Leader: Most righteous God, we remember in this supper the perfect sacrifice, offered once for all on the cross, by our Lord Jesus Christ for the sin of the whole world.

People: In the joy of the resurrection and in the expectation of his coming again, we offer ourselves to you as holy and living sacrifices. Send your Holy Spirit upon us, that the bread we break and the cup we bless may be to us the communion of the body and blood of Christ.

Leader: And God declares to us; For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is his love for those who fear him; as far as the east is from the west, so far has he removed our transgressions from us. As a father has compassion on his children, so the Lord has compassion on those who fear him.

Our Profession - HC Q&A1

Leader: What is your only comfort in life and in death?

All: That I am not my own, but belong — body and soul, in life and in death — to my faithful Savior Jesus Christ. He has fully paid for all my sins with his precious blood, and has set me free from the tyranny of the devil. He also watches over me in such a way that not a hair can fall from my head without the will of my Father in heaven; in fact, all things must work together for my salvation. Because I belong to him, Christ, by his Holy Spirit, assures me of eternal life and makes

me wholeheartedly willing and ready from now on to live for him.
