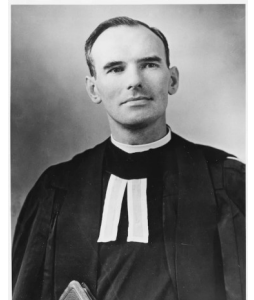
Sixty-seven years have passed as of this June since the words, "under God" were added to the Pledge of Allegiance. Though we largely take these words for granted now (and say them here every Sunday morning at the start of Sunday school), there is an interesting story about how they ended up in the modern Pledge.

The Pledge of Allegiance was first written, for children, by Rev. Francis Belamy, in 1892 as part of the nationalist surge surrounding the 400th anniversary of Columbus' discovery of America. His Pledge read: "I pledge allegiance to my flag and the Republic for which it stands — one Nation indivisible — with liberty and justice for all." Between 1922 and 1923 the words, "my flag," were changed to "the flag of the United States of America."

As the Cold War began and Communism became a greater threat, many people began to add the words "under God" to the Pledge. Illinois lawyer Louis Albert Bowman is credited as being the first person to publicly suggest this change, basing the idea on President Lincoln's words in the Gettysburg Address, "that the nation shall, under God, have a new birth of freedom." In 1951 the Knights of Columbus began to advocate for the addition of "under God," and by 1953 the idea was percolating within Congress itself.

However, the addition was ultimately made successful due to a single sermon preached with just the right person in the audience.

A Scottish-born minister, Rev. George Docherty, was the pastor of Washington's famed New York Avenue Presbyterian Church during this era, the church regularly attended by President Dwight Eisenhower. Docherty brought up the Pledge in a February 1954 sermon, saying, "To omit the words 'under God' in the Pledge of Allegiance is to omit the definitive factor in the American way of life." Eisenhower was convinced, and with that the legislative wheels began to turn. The President signed a bill adding "under God" into law on Flag Day, June 14, 1954.



Docherty would go on to be an important Civil Rights and anti-Vietnam War figure. He even appeared with Martin Luther King, Jr., in Selma, Alabama. His part in the "under God" story, however, especially proves that the people of God can influence our policy and our culture.

1-8 OZ pkg Mikesells/Seyferts corn puffs

In saucepan boil for 2 minutes:

1/2 pound butter

1 cup brown sugar

1/2 cup light corn syrup

add 1/4 T baking powder after boiling

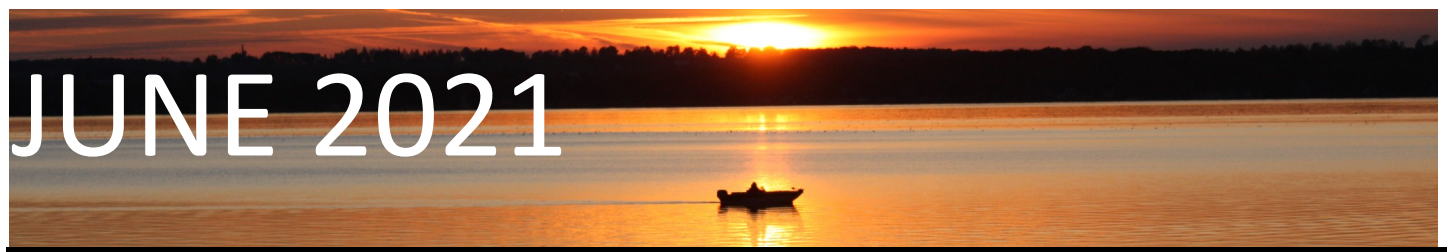

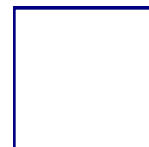

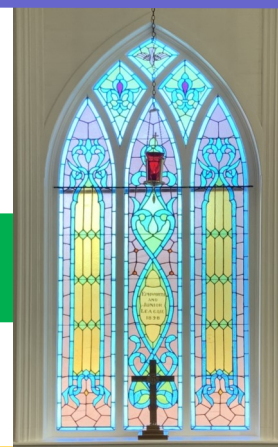
