"Faithful Living in a Foreign Land" Daniel 1-6



Cheap grace is grace without discipleship, grace without the cross, grace without Jesus Christ ... Costly grace is the kingly rule of Christ ... it is the call of Jesus Christ at which the disciple leaves his nets and follows him ... Above all, grace is costly because it cost God the life of his Son. (Dietrich Bonhoeffer, The Cost of Discipleship)

1. We need to be	to not be
to the diet of our culture	

At the end of the ten days they looked healthier and better nourished than any of the young men who ate the royal food. So the guard took away their choice food and the wine they were to drink and gave them vegetables instead. To these four young men God gave knowledge and understanding of all kinds of literature and learning. And Daniel could understand visions and dreams of all kinds (Daniel 1:15-17 NIV).

2. Being a Christ-follower is not always	

Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego replied to him, "King Nebuchadnezzar, we do not need to defend ourselves before you in this matter. If we are thrown into the blazing furnace, the God we serve is able to deliver us from it, and he will deliver us from Your Majesty's hand. But even if he does not, we want you to know, Your Majesty, that we will not serve your gods or worship the image of gold you have set up" (Daniel 3:16-18).

3. Our trust in God is not dependent on ______to go our way.

Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego came out of the fire, and the ... royal advisers crowded around them. They saw that the fire had not harmed their bodies, nor was a hair of their heads singed; their robes were not scorched, and there was no smell of fire on them (Daniel 3:26-27 NIV).

At this, the administrators and the satraps tried to find grounds for charges against Daniel in his conduct of government affairs, but they were unable to do so. They could find no corruption in him, because he was trustworthy and neither corrupt nor negligent. Finally these men said, "We will never find any basis for charges against this man Daniel unless it has something to do with the law of his God" (Daniel 6:4-5 NIV).

4. The way we live our lives should ______ to God.

"I issue a decree that in every part of my kingdom people must fear and reverence the God of Daniel: 'For he is the living God and he endures forever; his kingdom will not be destroyed, his dominion will never end. He rescues and he saves; he performs signs and wonders in the heavens and on the earth ..." (Daniel 6:26-27 NIV).

Dear friends, I urge you, as foreigners and exiles, to abstain from sinful desires, which wage war against your soul. Live such good lives among the pagans that, though they accuse you of doing wrong, they may see your good deeds and glorify God on the day he visits us (1 Peter 2:11-12 NIV).
