DB's Dabblings: "A Responsible Father"

You are witnesses, and God also, how holy and righteous and blameless was our conduct toward you believers. For you know how, like a father with his children, we exhorted each one of you and encouraged you and charged you to walk in a manner worthy of God, who calls you into his own kingdom and glory. (1 Thes. 2:10-12 ESV)

One of the responsibilities of a good father is to help our children learn how to "walk in a manner worthy of God." We do our children a disservice when we create in them a thoughtless acceptance of our truth without equipping them with the reasoning tools needed to discern the truth and a lifestyle that models their use. We all have a natural tendency to crave information consistent with what we already believe, this is called "confirmation bias." We tend to support facts and arguments that support our beliefs. The more we practice this, the more entrenched we become in our beliefs, even if they are false. Many of us believe we are good parents if we tell our kids what they are supposed to believe and make them believe it, but even if we are right in our faith that we are passing on, we have failed our children in not helping them learn how to examine the evidence with an open mind and come to their own convictions.

Jesus encouraged people to consider the evidence for his identity, not by just blindly accept his words. He encouraged people to become disciples, not just accept a legend. He encouraged them to carefully consider his teaching as coming from God, examine the evidence of the witnesses and his works, and study the Scriptures (see John 5). The Gospel of John is very clear about its purpose in John 20:30-31: "Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book; but these are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name." The Apostle John knew it was not the Lord's will that we just blindly accept He is the Christ, the Son of God, but that we should examine the evidence, discern the truth, and act upon it.

Jesus taught in the first Beatitude (Mat. 5:3) that we must be "poor in spirit" having the humility to be open to change in our thinking. The self-centered sinful nature that assumes our view is right without considering why leads us into sin (James 1:14-15). The humble heart that can examine the evidence and reach conviction that becomes personal faith will better live out that faith and help others to join their example through their loving influence for good. That's what good dads do. We model what we teach and encourage our children to follow as we help them develop their own faith. Think about this responsibility as you celebrate Father's Day.
