### A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Greetings Church Family,

I write this to you alongside almost 16,000 other brothers and sisters from Nashville, Tennessee. What a joy it has been to serve you all as a messenger at our Southern Baptist Convention this week. We elected a new president, Ed Litton from Alabama, whom I trust will lead our convention well for the next two years. In addition, resolutions were passed to protect people from abuse within the church. While the broader news sources like to suggest that we are a fractured denomination, I respectfully disagree and believe that we are united and convictionally stable as a denomination. We are still committed to holding the Bible to be The only Truth and unwavering Word of God. The tone of the convention was respectful and polite and light hearted. In addition to all of the great things that happened at the convention, one of the most encouraging moments was hearing about all of the great things Baptists are doing. Did you know that we currently have 3,631 missionaries serving around the world? Joining them are the 64 newly appointed missionaries we were able to commission and send out while in Nashville. In addition to that, Southern Baptists have planted over 8,200 churches in the past decade, accounting for 19% of baptisms within the total denomination. During COVID, Southern Baptists through Send Relief were able to distribute help and hope to over 1000 individuals. In addition, they saw more than 23,000 salvations! As if that was not exciting enough, the ERLC has committed to

placing 50 more ultrasound machines in pregnancy centers around the country over the next two years. What a great reminder for why we give and go. When we partner together, we are able to accomplish more for the mission of God. I am excited to continue our partnership and giving toward the cooperative program. Vision 2025 for the SBC includes 6 strategic actions, and I'm prayerfully excited to see how Memorial can partner together in these initiatives. It's an exciting day to be a Southern Baptist!
