LESSONS FROM FIRST SAMUEL

1 Samuel 5:1-8 After the Philistines had captured the ark of God, they took it from Ebenezer to **Ashdod**.² Then they carried the ark into Dagon's temple and set it beside Dagon. ³ When the people of Ashdod rose early the next day, there was Dagon, fallen on his face on the ground before the ark of the Lord! They took Dagon and put him back in his place. ⁴ But the following morning when they rose, there was Dagon, fallen on his face on the ground before the ark of the Lord! His head and hands had been broken off and were lying on the threshold; only his body remained. ⁶ The Lord's hand was heavy on the people of **Ashdod** and its vicinity; he brought devastation on them and afflicted them with tumors. ⁷ When the people of Ashdod saw what was happening, they said, "The ark of the god of Israel must not stay here with us, because his hand is heavy on us and on Dagon our god." ⁸ So they called together all the rulers of the Philistines and asked them, "What shall we do with the ark of the god of Israel?" They answered, "Have the ark of the god of Israel moved to **Gath**." [keep reading there's more...]

LESSONS FOR US:

- We reap what we sow.
 - Galatians 6:7 Do not be deceived: God cannot be mocked. A man **reaps** what he **sows**.
 - The Philistines **sowed** disrespect for the God of Israel. They **reaped** disrespect for their god when he was made to bow down to the Ark of the Covenant (the God of Israel).
 - The Philistines **sowed** pain and death to the Israelites. They **reaped** pain and death from the God of Israel in the form of tumors.
 - James 3:18 Peacemakers who **sow** in peace **reap** a harvest of righteousness.
