HYMN OF THE DAY: Today's hymn is one of my favorites, *How Firm a Foundation*. The first verse points us to the foundation of our faith, God's holy Word, and asks the question, "What more could God say to comfort us than he has already said?" The remaining verses are near quotations of Scripture. Thus we hear the voice of God speaking to us in each remaining verse, "Fear not! I am with you. O be not dismayed, for I am your God and will still give you aid." "The soul that on Jesus has leaned for repose I will not, I will not, desert to his foes." "When through fiery trials your pathway will lie, My grace, all sufficient, will be your supply." With such wonderful promises from God, we are able to persevere in our faith through all kinds of weakness, trouble, and affliction, even through death. God has assured us that we belong to him forever. Amen.

A WORD: In Today's gospel reading, Jesus says, "A prophet is not without honor, except in his hometown." The people of Jesus' hometown were indignant that Jesus claimed such wisdom and power for himself. Even though he was close to them, they didn't benefit from his presence because they didn't receive him through faith. There is a warning here for us. We are those close to Jesus today. We are his hometown because he dwells in the church. But even though we are close to Christ, we receive no benefit from him if we don't receive him by faith. So open your heart, trust Jesus as your savior, and receive all the good that God would bestow on you through him.

The Old Testament and epistle lessons are closely related. God calls the prophet Ezekiel to his work through a vision of heaven, a vision that Ezekiel describes in detail in chapters 1-2 of his book. Paul also has a vision, but unlike Ezekiel, he doesn't tell us anything about it. Why? Because he does not want anyone to think more highly of him than he ought. Paul boasts instead about a thorn in the flesh, a messenger of Satan that proves his weakness. In his weakness, he is fit to be a vessel of God's power. When Paul is weak, then he is strong through grace.

ABOUT THE BULLETIN COVER: It is not exactly a welcome homecoming when Jesus' own town of Nazareth chooses to see Him only according to what they know. Their unbelief prevents them from listening to His Word. By God's grace, Christ has welcomed us into the city of God by giving us ears to hear His Word and trust in Him. We are eternal citizens of His kingdom now because Christ has adopted us into the family of God by His cross and resurrection.
