We have now been in Papua New Guinea for 90 days!! An older pastor once told me that time doesn't go "tick, tick, tick," it goes "quick, quick, quick!" These last 3 months have been a whirlwind as we learn to live here and adjust to Papua New Guinea life. Things such as buying groceries, going to market, paying your power bill, or even opening a bank account can be so different, but by the grace of God, and the help of the Fair Families (both Bro Wayne and his son Eric are missionaries from our home church also serving here in the highlands of Papua New Guinea), we are adjusting well.

**On May 18<sup>th</sup>, we were blessed to be able to purchase a Toyota Landcruiser 10-seater.** It has very low mileage and has been maintained very well by the first owner. We praise the Lord for reliable transportation, and for the ability to make this purchase. This vehicle has plenty of room for our entire family and even a few more people if the need arises. Thank you for your prayers as we worked to make this purchase.

**Also, we were blessed to be able to sign a 12-month contract to rent a great house just outside of the city of Mount Hagen in an area called Tega.** We were excited to begin moving in on June 1<sup>st</sup>, and after a few days of cleaning and organizing, we finally can call this our new home!! The area is quiet and people are very friendly and we have been enjoying getting to talk with people as we go to the stores and market. We pray to one day be able to have a spiritual influence in these people's lives and even see some of them get saved.

Our language learning is coming along, slowly, but surely. We are able to have simple conversations with folks in town, but still have more to go before I will be able to teach Bible School without any help. I try to strike up a conversation with anyone who is willing to talk with me in order to "practice." **Please continue to pray as we labor to learn this language and the culture here in the highlands of Papua New Guinea.**

These last few months, I have had the pleasure of meeting and getting to know some of the local pastors here in this area. Some of these men have a real desire to partner with the Bible Institute ministry that we believe that Lord has called us to do. We are still praying about the logistics of this school, but we are taking our time to get better acquainted with the brethren here as I still need to master the Tok Pisin Language. **Please pray with us that God will give the direction necessary to allow this effort to be done in unity and for His honour and glory.**

**Lastly, this week (July 2<sup>nd</sup>-July 8<sup>th</sup>) our family will be headed out to the "bush" with Bro Wayne Fair and his wife to check on their mission station and the church in the little village of Kaware, in the Southern Highlands province.** We have some work to do, including some repairs on the buildings, as well as helping some of the churches out there with some of their projects. We are also excited to be able to spend both Sunday and Wednesday services with these dear people. When my wife was a teenager, she was able to spend a total of 8 months in Kaware with the Fair family, and now we are excited to go back and introduce our children to this village and the church there! **Please pray for safety as we travel almost 5 hours one way, and for God to allow us to be a blessing in whatever way he sees fit.**
