#### CHURCH OFFICES CLOSED

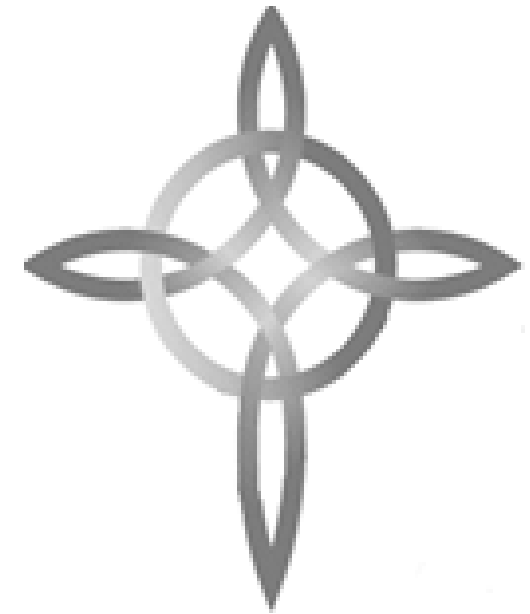
The church offices will be closed in observance of Independence Day.
