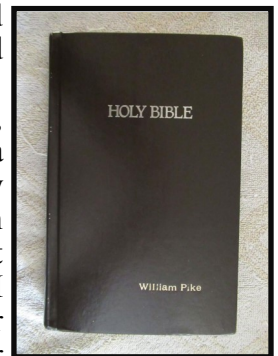

Dear Friends,

Many churches, including our own, have the tradition of presenting a Bible to graduating high school seniors. So did South Salem United Methodist Church, where I first began my Christian walk as a teenager in south-central Ohio.

Recently I happened to notice that as of May of this year, that Bible has been in my possession for 30 years. Long ago, inside the front cover, I had written, "From South Salem United Methodist Church for Graduation Sunday, May 19, 1991."

I still remember that day, as Pastor Garry Hogue handed me two wrapped books. One was a hardcover copy of Oswald Chambers' famous devotional, *My Utmost for His Highest*. The other was this Bible. My name was imprinted on each one, something which impressed me greatly – I doubt I'd ever seen a book imprinted with the owner's name like that before. To my great surprise, a few days later my father came home from work and handed me a leather case he had purchased for that Bible from a stationary store that once existed in our area. I still keep the Bible in that same case today, and somehow, after thirty years of use, case and Bible both are still no worse for wear.



Sometime, probably that same summer, I tried to begin reading the Bible, for the first time, from the beginning. At some point, probably having reached Leviticus, I gave up for a while. But later on while in college I began again, starting this time with the New Testament. After I finished the New Testament I returned to the Old Testament again, now with a greater interest, and eventually finished reading the Bible for the first time. My pages are replete with underlinings, brackets, and notes made during that first reading, back in my early 20s.

I have owned and made use of several Bibles in the years since, but it is still this well-worn NIV copy to which I return, and from which I preach every Sunday. It has accompanied me through many journeys – physical and spiritual – and it has inspired me time and time again.

I have to wonder if, on that Sunday in May thirty years ago, anyone in the church that day thought twice about the Bible that was given to me. Did anyone there really think I would read it. Did they think it would touch my life at all. I wish I could go back in time and tell them that efforts like that are worth it, and God's word endures, as has this simple copy of the scriptures, entering now its fourth decade, and with so much left to give me.

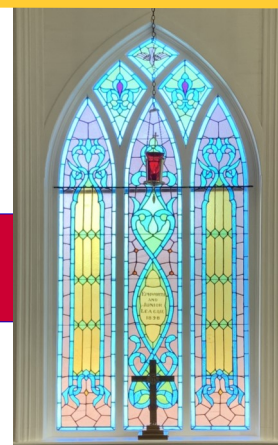
