I pray you are off to a great summer! I am so excited to introduce you to Faithlife.com, a wonderful host of resources to help churches and Christians grow in Christ. Faithlife is centered around an online community where we have a Church Group — *Hollins Road Baptist Church*. Our Church Group page is where you can access so much. The "feel" is similar to Facebook. There is an activity feed where you can see posts (pictures, prayer requests and things posted by our members). On the left side panel of our Church Group page, you can find announcements, our calendar, Church Group members (list), Church Directory, group chat, and the list of teams or groups you have joined. On the right side panel, you will find links to our Urgent Prayer Needs, Logos Bible study program (loaded with helpful resources), Faithlife TV (with over 1000 Christian movies, children's movies, documentaries, over 260 Bible Study courses under Mobile Ed, etc.), a Group Reading list, some other prayer needs and a Bible verse for the day!

A great feature of Faithlife is that all of our Team Ministries and Groups have their own Team or Group page. This is where they can collaborate together - chat, hold meetings and even use the video chat (similar to Zoom) to meet remotely! Pretty cool!

With Faithlife we now have a new website and church app. And Online Giving is available in all areas (Church Group page, website and church app). You can also utilize our text giving feature. Just text the word GIVE and the amount to 540-208-2622. For example: GIVE 200 (and \$200 will be given to our General Fund). You can also give to any of our designated funds. For example: GIVE 100 Mortgage Payment. You can also do multiple gifts at the same time. For example: GIVE 200 General Fund 100 Mortgage Payment 100 AC Fund. Pretty cool! And the beauty of Faithlife is YOU can track your giving at any time on your My Faithlife page. (This is the first page you see once you REGISTER for Faithlife and the one you see when you sign-in each time.)

Another exciting feature is the Church Management part of this. Once you REGISTER to sign up for Faithlife and then join our Group...Hollins Road Baptist Church, you can enter your own personal information (address, home phone, mobile phone, email address, family connections, spiritual gifts, other important information about you, etc.). This will ensure we have your most up-to-date information. And if your address or email or mobile phone number changes, YOU can update it yourself! We trust you will! Pretty cool! And please add a photo for our digital directory...you can change it as often as you desire. (You should find some of your information already there since we have imported all of our data from our old management program. So please verify and update and add what is needed.)

On your My Faithlife page's upper left side panel, you see Settings. Click there and it will take you to the page where you can set your Profile and Notifications (how you want to be notified and when). Make sure when you set up your Profile that the box by your mobile phone is checked indicating it is okay to text you (will use this for urgent push notifications). And make sure the box saying it is okay to publish you in our directory is checked (unless you do not want to be published in it). Note: only our members will see this!

Our goal is to get everyone who has a computer and smartphone to REGISTER for Faithlife and join our Church Group. This will get you more connected with all that is going on, build our community together, encourage you in your faith and help you grow in your walk with the Lord! I know it may be a little overwhelming at first, but once you get REGISTERED and joined in our Church Group and community, you will see it really is not too difficult. And you will see how powerful and beneficial this tool is!

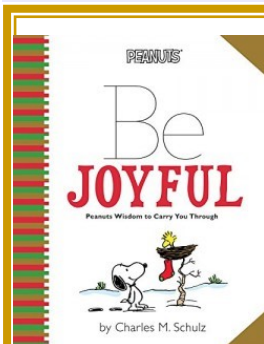

Kroger Charitable Donation Program

If you shop at Kroger and have a Kroger Plus Card (you can get one for free) and have not already registered your card's number in Kroger's charity donation program, please do so now. This benefits your church in a great way! Our Church is registered with Kroger and our special number (Community Reward code) is DX529.

You can register in 2 ways:

Go to the Kroger website. Set up your account then choose "Community Rewards." Follow the instructions there to set up and use the special code DX529 for Hollins Road Baptist Church.

Call 1-800-576-4377. Select the prompt for "Community Rewards." You can then speak with someone and ask them to register your Kroger Plus Card to your church Hollins Road Baptist code DX529.

(You can double check to see if you are registered.)

How this works. Every time you use your Kroger Plus Card (for groceries, gas, pharmacy, purchasing gift cards, etc.) a \$ percentage is registered to Hollins Road Baptist Church. And then each quarter, they send a donation check to Hollins Road Baptist added up from all our members who've registered! This is a great way you can help our Nicaragua mission efforts. **The money generated from this helps to pay at least one of our staff member's way to Nicaragua. 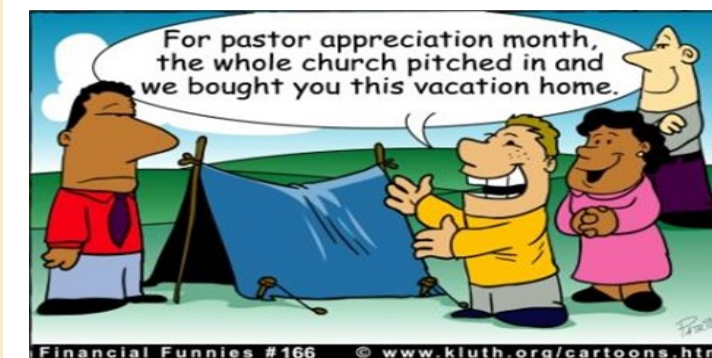
