DB's Dabblings: "The Worldwide Family of God"

In our "Teamwork" sermon series focused on "Going Back Better Than Normal," we have been taking principles from Nehemiah's work in rebuilding the walls and restoring the infrastructure of the city of Jerusalem after their return from captivity. We have mainly focused on the local church, specifically the Graham Street Church of Christ in Stephenville, Texas. The seven principles we have identified for our teamwork as a congregation to "go back better than normal" are:

- 1. They made a commitment to a specific mission and began the work (2:17-18)
- 2. They prayed believing God would give them success as they worked together (2:20)
- 3. They divided up the work as they worked together for common goals (chapter 3)
- 4. They all worked with all their heart (4:6)
- 5. They protected and encouraged each other as they worked (4:9-23)
- 6. They celebrated the success together after completing the wall in 52 days (6:15-16)
- 7. They recommitted to continuing to build on the foundation of God's Word (Chp. 8)

We are on principle #5 making application of the church protecting and encouraging each other because we are the "Family of God." Again, the emphasis I am making in my sermons is directed to the Graham Street Church Family, but we need to remember that the Family of God is worldwide and the principles we are applying to our specific church family can also be applied to the larger family of God all over the world.

I was readily reminded this week of what a wonderful church family we are a part of at Graham Street as so many reached out to us while Vicki is recovering from knee replacement revision surgery. So many offered to bring food that it was somewhat overwhelming. I can't begin to count how many calls, texts and emails I have received from our church family that we are being prayed for. I have had all kinds of offers from my GSCOC brothers and sisters to help with whatever I need as I take care of Vicki. Thank you so much for demonstrating what it means to be a church family. I love you all.

In addition to having a great local church family, we have a much larger Church Family! My Christian neighbors who were part of our "house church" meeting during COVID have extended the same loving care. My grass has been mowed, food given, and when they heard that Vicki's pathology report showed an infection that would need treatment, they circled around her in our living room to pray for her. We have had well wishes and prayers from the Christians at the school where Vicki works. We are in the prayers of the ministers in the Ministerial Alliance and the churches affiliated. I have received prayer messages from churches all over the United States. But I have to admit my eyes teared up when I began to get encouragement from brothers and sisters in Zimbabwe, China, Ireland, and Turkey. Praise God that we are a part of, not only a great local church family at Graham Street Church of Christ, but also the Family of God Worldwide!


