Dear friends,

Welcome to St Peters this morning. It is our hope and prayer that you will learn from God's Word, be encouraged and be more determined to follow Jesus. If you are new or visiting, please fill in a visitor's card so we can keep in contact.

In Term 3 we will have two short series in the Old Testament: four sermons in Jonah then four sermons in Esther. The first sermon in Jonah is on Sunday 1st August. Available today are six studies in Jonah by Andrew Reid. I have bought a license for 50 copies. 30 printed copies on the back table as well as digital files in Word or pdf format. If you want a digital copy let me know as I cannot upload to the website.

The plan is to use five studies starting this week, to coincide with sermons. Jonah 1 in the first study, then study 2 looking at the Hebrew word 'Hesed' (Loving kindness) in the Old Testament, important for studying the rest of Jonah. After Study 5 in Jonah, we will then turn to Esther, for which I am writing four studies, available in a few weeks, then the last week of term come back to Study 6 in Jonah, considering its use in the New Testament. Any questions let me know.
