



Greetings from Yokosuka, Japan

We thank each of you for your faithfulness to pray for and support us as your missionaries to the U.S. Military. We have had an interesting last couple week. We met with our realtor and landlord on Thursday and found out that our landlord is retiring. Additionally, he intends to sell the property/building where we have held services for the past 15 years. This caught us completely by surprise since just a couple weeks earlier he had stated he wanted to rent to us for a long time to come. He offered to sell it to us for ¥100,000,000 which equates to approximately \$905,000.00. After doing some research into the property, we have found that it is not worth the amount being asked and we are going to counter with a more realistic proposal of around ¥75,000,000 (approx \$678,000.00). As a church, we will be praying and fasting about this situation. We are able to cover a portion of the purchase price (\$678,000.00) but are asking each of you to please pray about partnering with us to purchase this land and building. We are trying to raise a minimum of \$100,000.00 to go toward the purchase. Any donations toward this effort can be sent to account 1428 at BIMJ and these funds will be used specifically for the building.
