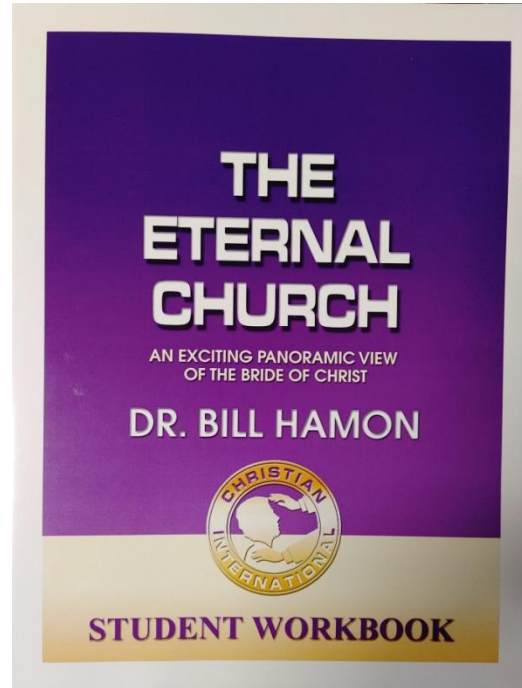

- b) Place- Europe was its place of birth and growth
- c) People- Those that came out of the Catholic Church

- f) Message- Repentance from dead works
- g) Ministry- Preaching the Word
- h) Method- By faith in God and by the use of every meaning available

F. The Holiness Movement

- 1) Insights Gained By Studying "Types & Shadows"
 - a) The time for more restoration of truth had arrived.
 - b) **History of Israel** was written for a typological illustration of what would happen to the Church (I Cor.10:11).

THE RESTORATION OF THE CHURCH PG 78

Egypt - Passover - represents truth restored in Protestant Movement

(1) Red Sea, (2) Standing on Banks of Jordan, (3) Drinking waters of Marah represents the truth restored during the Holiness Movement.

The church is making the same journey spiritually: first, the children of Israel came to the Red Sea and were separated by the water, then they danced, sang and rejoiced with great emotional frenzy on the banks of Jordan and last, they advanced to the bitter waters of Marah

where God made a covenant of healing and delivered them from all their sickness. Similarly, the three phases of the "faith Toward God" doctrine were restored **in the same sequential order.**

- Water Baptism- became the doctrine of all Holiness
- Sanctification- Restored during 18 +19 century by John Wesley
- Divine Faith Healing- Restored during middle part of 17th century by A. B. Simpson + Christian Missionary Alliance Church

Sequential order-

Protestant Movement: **The Brazen Alter-**
Justification

Holiness Movement: **Laver-** Water Baptism and
Sanctification

Table of Shewbread- Divine Healing

Explanation of "Holiness Movement" and Restoration of the "Faith Toward God" Doctrine According to the chart

2) Approximate date A.D. 1800 (left hand margin of chart) The Truth restored during the restoration of the "Faith Toward god" Doctrine of Christ Over a 30040 period.

3) Sanctification

Spiritual Experiences- Sanctification : Conviction Faith, Hymns Joy, Singing

THE RESTORATION OF THE CHURCH PG 80

a) Sanctification was the major restoration truth of the Holiness Movement. The word saint, sanctify and holy come from the same Greek root (hag) which means set apart, separate holy.

The Methodist Church became known as the representative of the sanctification message like the Baptist were known for the water baptism phase of the "Faith Toward God" restorational doctrine.

THE RESTORATION OF THE CHURCH PG 80

The *Holiness* teachings had two emphases:

- In word work of Sanctification, an enducement of Power for Holy living
 - worldliness- the rights and wrong for Christians
- b) **Conviction**-Protestant- against use of religious works as a means of justification w/o teaching

Holiness Movement- Sin was made exceedingly sinful
sactification of the soul and separation from the world.

c) Faith, Joy, Hymns, singing -

1) Faith- 3 Levels of Faith

- Saving Faith
- Fruit of Faith
- Gift of Faith

2) Joy, Hymns, Singing -

singing become a part of the gospel message and worship service.

Note: Every Restorational truth is accompanied by holy spirit inspired songs and hymns that express the truth and life giving experiences being restored by the church members.

Release of the Soul- The Holiness Movement gave the Soul its release in expressing love, worship, praise and prayer to God.

Two Examples:

- Because of their falling to the floor while sometimes jerking and rolling, they were tagged "holy rollers"
- Students were smitten w/ Jerks + talking in unkown tongues after attending camp meetings

Doctrines Without Doing- The Holiness Movement brought what the Church saw as "unusual physical manifestations." But we must remember that the Early Church went into the Dark Ages because men became more interested in doctrine than experience

Doctrine is the wood of the Church, but divine emotion and zeal is the Fire!

a) *Faith toward* God was the **second Doctrine of Christ to be reestablished** in the Church as a functioning truth.

Every restorational truth will be established in the church and received by members as they have faith for it. The Holy Spirit inspires faith to believe and receive when it is time to bring fulfillment.

- b) **Truth Movements Also Spawn Counterfeits-** There can be such things as a counterfeit unless there is a genuine.
- c) **Truth Becomes Neutralized-** by denominational tradition
- d) **Restoration of a Faith-Experience brought Reality back to Faith Towards God-** The Holiness Movement reactivated the justification by faith truth back to its original reality.
