DB's Dabblings: "So, What's Happening Next Semester?

Back to School Sunday is August 22 and we will begin the new Children's Ministry Education classes that morning with a special introduction to "The Story." Darlene Hearne is directing our Sunday morning Children's Bible Classes. The Children's Worship program will re-start that morning for ages 3-5 directed by Nichole Wilson. We will be having hamburgers at the Family Center after worship services by Grill Master David Tomlinson!

Although it is still Summer, one of our new Adult Sunday morning classes begins August 15 when Hughbert Collier will be teaching the Book of Revelation in the auditorium. We will resume the GPS Class (Godly Parenting Skills) the Sunday after Labor Day, September 12. Our class topic for this semester is, "Better Parents through Better Marriages." This class is for anyone who would like to improve your marriage, even if you don't have children in your home, and even if you are just planning on getting married someday. Yes, there will be homework, but you will enjoy it! Here are some marriage topics we will work on:

- Momentum—assessing how you are really doing
- Mindset-attitudes toward marriage
- Wellbeing—an exploration of your psychological and emotional health
- **Context** clarifying what "baggage" each person has brought into the relationship, specifically social support, finances, and role expectations
- **Dynamics**—exploring how different personalities interact in the areas of Love and Sex, Attitudes, Communication, Bridging the Gender Gap, Conflict, and Spirituality

On **Wednesday nights** after Labor Day we are going to try something different. The idea is to meet together in the auditorium where I will share a **short devotional thought, no more than 15 minutes on a name, title, or characteristic of God.** Then we will break into groups to discuss and apply these thoughts to worshiping and serving God as described in the devotional. Right now, depending on attendance, we are thinking about adult groups, a Family Bible Class for parents and small children, a group for older kids and pre-teens, and the teens would re-start REVIVE. We will need good attendance and a lot of help to get the most out of this **Family Life Ministry approach to Wednesday night classes.**

Sunday afternoons and evenings during the fall semester will continue to have small group meetings on the 1st and 3rd Sundays. We hope that our Wednesday night Family Life Ministry classes will develop more small groups meetings we call SFGs (Spiritual Formation Groups). We will continue to have Sunday afternoon luncheons, but only on the 4th Sundays of the month. There are some special fellowship plans being developed for the 2nd Sundays, which we will announce later.
