**Psalm 111:2 "Great are the works of the Lord,
studied by all who delight in them."**

1. The Torah provides the frame for all prophecy
2. Recognize Prophecy is progressive
3. Recognize that Old Testament prophecy does not clearly distinguish the two comings of Christ as single events separated by thousands of years
4. Expect First and second coming similarities in the scriptures
5. Prophecy like history is a survey and not a complete account
6. OT prophetic topics need to be understood in context before you go to the NT

Conclusion: why prophecy promotes holiness
