As we move into September we will be restoring much of the pre-Covid pattern of weekend Masses:

- Saturday 6pm St Edmund's.
- Sunday 8.45am St John's (with children's liturgy)
- Sunday 10.30am St Joseph's

Our final 6pm **livestream** is on 14th August. We are pleased that it has been helpful to a number of people and are very happy to recommend the very popular livestream from St Joseph's, Guildford.

We have also decided to leave the St Joseph's Mass at the slightly later time of 10.30am so that there is less of a rush for the priest going from one to the other.

Saturday morning Mass will revert to the Mass of the day, usually at St Edmund's.

Aware that COVID is likely to still be in circulation we will keep seating to every other bench and ask everyone to wear face coverings and to register. It is likely that there will be spare places on most occasions.

We are committed to working with Public Health England to build confidence in people that the church remains a safe place to enter and worship.
