

August 22, 2021 Sunday DB's Dabblings: "Loving to Learn"

I was asked to lead a Prayer Walk at Central Elementary, so Tuesday, the day before the first day of school, I had a wonderful experience with Wes Wilson and Cory Devivo walking the hallways with the staff and teachers saying prayers for each section of the school in preparation for the next day. Before we started, I read Mat. 19:13-15 along something I wrote for the occasion. I wanted to share it with you and apply it to our "Back to School Sunday."

Then children were brought to him that he might lay his hands on them and pray. The disciples rebuked the people, but Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me and do not hinder them, for to such belongs the kingdom of heaven." And he laid his hands on them and went away. (Mat. 19:13-15) Parents will bring their children to Central for a blessing, but some will think what happens here is not worth the time, effort and money spent on it. But like Jesus, Central brings the children in and blesses them, because

CENTRAL IS SACRED GROUND

We stand in a sacred place. A place where young minds and hearts will develop an attitude, about school and learning that will last throughout their lives. They will come with their excitement and anticipation, and with their anxiety and fears. This will be a place where they will learn about: numbers, letters, shapes, colors, patterns and how they all work together to read, write, count, and create. And this will open for them a whole new world. But they will also learn to learn, and if they do, and love it, they will be life-long learners. And with that foundation, they will approach all of life as a learner. One who applies themselves to truth, and honest evaluation, and in finding ways to make the world a better place and to form better relationships.

And as a learner, they will leave room to discover the spiritual beyond the physical, and the values that go beyond self-interest. But if we break their trust, and squander this opportunity, allowing them to pass through these halls and not learn to love learning, they may well accept a cruel world of hurt from which it will be impossible for them to find the tools to escape. What we pray for, as we walk these sacred hallways, is more than for a good year. For here, on this sacred ground, we ask God to work a miracle, an eternal impact on every individual piece of eternity that is touched by what happens here.

If it is important for us to realize this about the education in our local schools, don't you think we should feel a strong responsibility to making our very best effort for our children in our Bible Classes? Doesn't that make our investment and efforts into our Youth and Family Ministry a top priority for this church? Isn't making "Back to School Sunday" a day to excite children to love to learn about God and find studying the Bible a joyful experience a very important mission for the Graham Street Church of Christ?

Remember the emphasis Jesus put on children:

At that time the disciples came to Jesus, saying, "Who is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven?" And calling to him a child, he put him in the midst of them and said, "Truly, I say to you, unless you turn and become like children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven. Whoever humbles himself like this child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven. "Whoever receives one such child in my name receives me, but whoever causes one of these little ones who believe in me to sin, it would be better for him to have a great millstone fastened around his neck and to be drowned in the depth of the sea. (Mat. 18:1-6)



Classes for all ages. We will all meet in the auditorium for a short devotional focused on God's Name and then break into classes in various places in the building.


