

Newborn-3 ½ yrs: Nursery

3 ½ yrs - 5th grade: Treasure Hiders - Kids will spend time playing games and doing activities that will help them to memorize Foundational Bible Verses (hiding treasure in their hearts). They will work to memorize some verses during the evening and also be encouraged to memorize more on their own.

6th-8th grade: Catechism - Pastor John will lead students through a study of the foundational creeds and beliefs of our church, such as those found in the Heidelberg Catechism.

9th-12th grade: Service and Fellowship - Recognizing that there will be many schedule conflicts for this age group, Wednesday nights will be an opportunity for the youth to fellowship with one another and also to choose to serve our congregation through helping with the dinner, cleanup, nursery, and/or elementary age ministries.

Marriage Ministry - One of the foundational covenant relationships that God establishes in His word

is marriage, and yet we sometimes struggle to set aside a regular time to work on that relationship. By strengthening our marital relationships, we will also strengthen our families, our church, and our communities.
