We will have a Church Fellowship Luncheon on the 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday, which we will use to meet new members and get to know our guests, and encourage them to attend the Connecting Point small group.

**Now for Wednesday nights.** We will wrap up the *Living Faith* series Wednesday night, Sept. 1 with a Soup and Sandwich Supper at 5:30 in the Family Center (**Bring lots of sandwiches!**). We will talk about what was accomplished and share stories of lives that were touched by the activities on Wednesday nights this summer. We will wrap up by 6:30, and Wes will restart REVIVE for the  $6^{th} - 12^{th}$  Graders in the Family Center. The new Wednesday night program will start after Labor Day, Sept. 8. We will bring back our Wednesday night meals under Le Jones' direction from 5:30 to 6:15 in the Family Center. At 6:30, I will lead a devotional for everybody in the main auditorium focusing on a name, title or description of God that we will study in our classes. We will break out for our classes by 6:45 and they will dismiss at 7:30. Whitney Holt is directing the...
