**Westminster Shorter Catechism #64:** *What does the fifth commandment require?* The fifth commandment requires us to respect and treat others, whether above, below, or equal to us, as their position or our relationship to them demands.

**The Lord's Supper at Westminster** is for all those who have received Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord, who do now repent, endeavor to live a holy life, and have publicly professed their faith through membership in an evangelical church. Children who have not publicly confessed Christ by being received by the Session into communicant Church membership should refrain from the Sacrament and learn by reverent observation; this, even though they may already have received Christ privately. Those without personal saving faith in Jesus Christ are to refrain from the Sacrament and are urged to repent and receive Him by faith. *\*The bread is gluten free.*
