In our last prayer letter, I mentioned that our family would be going out to the village of Kaware in the Southern Highlands with Wayne and Sue Fair. We had a wonderful time with the church there, but once we arrived, Bro Wayne told me that he wouldn't be translating for me, and that it was time for me to preach in Tok Pisin by myself. I was pretty worried, but God gave me strength and the services turned out well!! Since then, for the last 2 months, I have been preaching without an interpreter. I still have plenty of work to get as fluent as I should, but by God's grace I am learning more every day.

When we returned to Mount Hagen, Pastor Cumulus Kumbi asked Wayne Fair and I to preach a special 4day evangelistic meeting for his church, Temple Baptist Church. He was encouraged to see the folks in the church stirred up and over the course of about 3 weeks, approximately 22 people trusted the Lord as their Saviour and were saved!! I was also blessed to get an opportunity to preach at some of the other Baptist churches here in Mount Hagen these last few months. Both Narrow Way Baptist Church, and Bible Truth Baptist Church invited me to preach for them on for a Sunday morning service, and between these 2 churches, 3 more people were gloriously saved!!

Please continue to pray as we strive to develop relationships with these pastors in Mount Hagen, in order to be able to properly start the Bible School in the Lord's timing.

Sheila was also asked to speak at a ladies meeting at Bible Truth Baptist Church this last month. The ladies had a wonderful time of fellowship and encouragement with one another, and Sheila was also able to speak in the Tok Pisin Language at this ladies fellowship, "The Joyful Women."

This month, I have also began teaching adult Sunday School for the folks at Temple Baptist Church. I will be teaching verse by verse through the book of 1 Thessalonians. Please pray that the Lord will give me clarity of mind as I will be teaching in Tok Pisin, and I surely don't want a language slip-up to cause anyone to be confused about something in the Scriptures.

This last month, I was also honored to be asked to preach for the Nebilyer Valley pastor's fellowship at Nebilver Baptist Church. Pastor Philemon and a few of the other pastors in the Nebilver Valley have been working to get a Bible School open in their area (about 30 minutes outside of Mount Hagen). They are almost finished with their first year of Bible School, but they have asked me to help them moving forward by teaching some classes to finish out this year and next year. They have also asked me to help them by taking the role of a "principal" by handling some organization/administration as they move forward

After much prayer, I agreed to teach 2 classes, Rightly Dividing, and Biblical Prophecy, for the rest of this school year, and possibly even a few more additional classes next year, and agreed to give them an answer regarding the other responsibilities of "principal" by December. Please pray for this opportunity and the Lord's wisdom as we labor in this ministry moving forward.

Lastly, our family has been going to a few small villages (Kenta, Ruo, Rugi, and Kentablok) near our house to do some outreach. These villages have no bible preaching church in them, but so far have been very welcoming to us as we walk around giving out tracts. They have even invited us to come back a few times to preach to the folks there, and we are excited about this open door. Please pray for the gospel to reach these folks in this area so that many might be saved.
