During Open Week, Trinity's ethos and approach to theological education will be outlined along with essential course information. Staff and students will be on hand to answer questions and people will get a taste of College life.

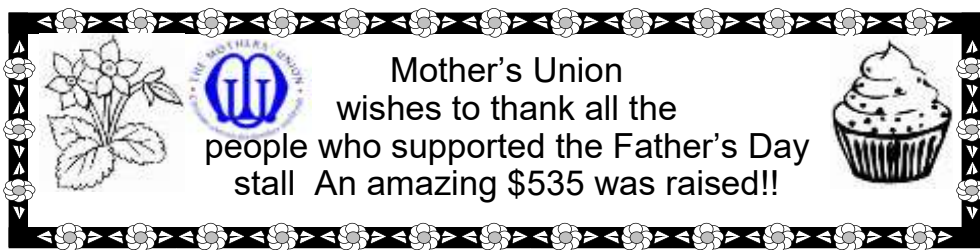
