The “antichrist receives his crown” and world domination...he is represented as the rider on the white horse. Rev. 6:2

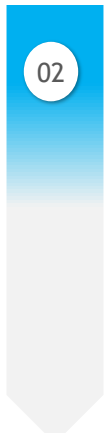


S1

Seal Two



The rider on the bright red horse causes war represented by a sword. Rev.6:3-4

Seal Three



The rider of the black horse has power over the world’s economy. Yet, he doesn’t harm the earth or its needed resources. Rev. 6:5-6

Seal Four



The ride of the pale horse is given power to kill millions by famine, sickness and war. Rev. 6: 7-8.

Seal Five



Souls under Yahweh’s altar are awaiting to be avenged. God says to wait until all servants are sealed. They receive white robes. Rev. 6:9-11

Seal Six



The sky, sun, and moon are shrouded in darkness. The world and its leaders run and hide anywhere they can find. Rev. 6:12-17

Seal Seven



Jesus Christ prepares with great authority to cast judgement on the wicked and reward His faithful servants. The seven trumpets are then blown. Rev. 8,9

The Two Witnesses show power, testimony, then die and then Christ returns! Rev.10-12.
