Dear Church Family,

That way of thinking must come to an end, and we must be obedient to the Word of God and share the love of Christ with everyone we come in contact with. My prayer is that this "new way of thinking" becomes the heartbeat of our church moving forward and that God reaps a mighty harvest of new and renewed believers!

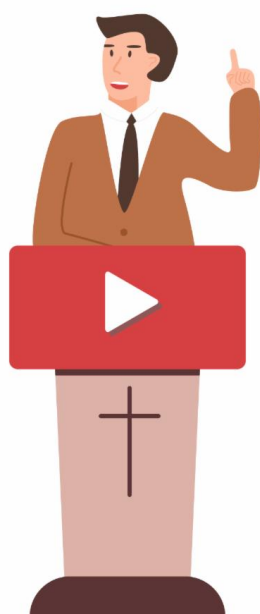
