Twice a year BCA request their money boxes are brought in for counting.

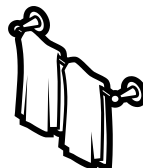
Can those people participating in the BCA money boxes please bring them into the parish office over the next few weeks.

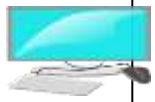
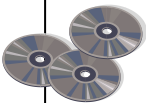
