He is currently the Senior Pastor of United Faith Fellowship Church of God in Meadville, PA and author of the book *Divorced Over Toilet Paper*.

## Working “Together”... Together Track

This track is for people who want to dig in deeper to the problem of unity facing the Church: **Markus McDaniel**

## What is the cost?
