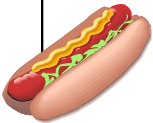

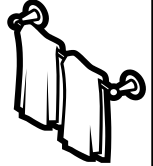

Can those people who are rostered to clean the church and take the tea towels home to wash, please check at home to see if there are any which need to be returned?

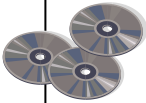
