230 Who needs the new birth?

Everyone needs the new birth because all are spiritually dead and therefore cannot enter the Kingdom of God.

John 3:16 That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.

231 By what means does the new birth come to a person?

The new birth comes to us by means of the Word of God and baptism.

Titus 3:4-7 But when the goodness and loving kindness of God our Savior appeared, he saved us, not because of works done by us in righteousness, but according to his own mercy, by the washing of regeneration and


renewal of the Holy Spirit, whom he poured out on us richly through Jesus Christ our Savior, so that being justified by his grace we might become heirs according to the hope of eternal life.

John 3:5 Jesus answered, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God.

1 Peter 1:23 since you have been born again, not of perishable seed but of imperishable, through the living and abiding word of God ...

Romans 10:17 So faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ.

1 Peter 3:20-22 ... the ark was being prepared, in which a few, that is, eight persons, were brought safely through water. Baptism, which corresponds to this, now saves you, not as a removal of dirt from the body but as an appeal to God for a good conscience, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ, who has gone into heaven and is at the right hand of God, with angels, authorities, and powers having been subjected to him.
