
FIXING OUR EYES ON JESUS!


I am poured out like water, and all my bones are out of joint: my heart is like wax; it is melted in the midst of my bowels.(Psa 22:14)







Jesus is our 2nd Adam!

- Both were federal heads
- Adam was sinless and chose sin
- Both's actions affected us all
- Jesus is the "seed" of the woman and fully man <u>but without sin</u>

WHO IS JESUS?

Jesus was considered and worshipped as God (John 1:1, 18; Philippians 2:9-11; Hebrews 1:6; Revelation 5:13)

WILLGOD Jesus is called Lord (a title given to God alone) (Matthew 3:3, 22:44; Luke 2:11; 1 Corinthians 8:6)

Jesus possesses attributes of God

- Omnipotence (Matthew 8:26-27, 14:19; John 2:1-11)
- Eternality (John 8:58; Revelation 22:13)
- Omniscience (Mark 2:8: John 1:48, 6:64)
- Sovereignty (Mark 2:5-7)
- Immortality (John 2:19)

Jesus was sinless (Hebrews 4:15, 7:26; 1 Peter 1:19; 1 John 3:5)

Jesus was tempted (Matthew 4:1-11; Hebrews 4:15)

The divinity and humanity of Jesus are distinct

The divinity and humanity of Jesus are united in the one person of Jesus

Isaiah 9:6; Luke 2:11; John 1:14: Romans 1:3-4: 1 Corinthians 2:8; Galatians 4:4-5

Jesus had a Jewish lineage (Matthew 1:1-17; Romans 1:3)

> Jesus was born of a woman (Matthew 1:18-25; Luke 2:1-7)

Jesus had a human body

- He grew (Luke 2:52)
- He tired (John 4:6)
- He thirsted (John 19:28)
- He hungered (Matthew 4:2)
- ·He died (Matthew 27:45-54; Mark 15:33-41; Luke 23:44-49; John 19:28-30)

Jesus had human emotions (John 11:35: 12:27; Matthew 26:38; Hebrews 5:7)

Jesus was seen, heard, and touched (John 20:24-29:1 John 1:1)

He rose from the dead (Matthew 28:1-10; 1 Corinthians 15:1-8)

- Became a curse




Garden to Garden


- "so that by the grace of God He might taste death for everyone."
