

---


- God is Spirit, Man is flesh/blood





# WHO IS JESUS?

FULLY GOD

Jesus was considered and worshipped as God (*John 1:1, 18; Philippians 2:9-11; Hebrews 1:6; Revelation 5:13*)

Jesus is called Lord (a title given to God alone) (*Matthew 3:3, 22:44; Luke 2:11; 1 Corinthians 8:6*)

Jesus possesses attributes of God

- Omnipotence (*Matthew 8:26-27, 14:19; John 2:1-11*)
- Eternality (*John 8:58; Revelation 22:13*)
- Omniscience (*Mark 2:8; John 1:48, 6:64*)
- Sovereignty (*Mark 2:5-7*)
- Immortality (*John 2:19*)

Jesus was sinless (*Hebrews 4:15, 7:26; 1 Peter 1:19; 1 John 3:5*)

He rose from the dead (*Matthew 28:1-10; 1 Corinthians 15:1-8*)

The divinity and humanity of Jesus are distinct

The divinity and humanity of Jesus are united in the one person of Jesus

*Isaiah 9:6; Luke 2:11; John 1:14; Romans 1:3-4; 1 Corinthians 2:8; Galatians 4:4-5*

Jesus was tempted (*Matthew 4:1-11; Hebrews 4:15*)

Jesus had a Jewish lineage (*Matthew 1:1-17; Romans 1:3*)

Jesus was born of a woman (*Matthew 1:18-25; Luke 2:1-7*)

Jesus had a human body

- He grew (*Luke 2:52*)
- He tired (*John 4:6*)
- He thirsted (*John 19:28*)
- He hungered (*Matthew 4:2*)
- He died (*Matthew 27:45-54; Mark 15:33-41; Luke 23:44-49; John 19:28-30*)

Jesus had human emotions (*John 11:35; 12:27; Matthew 26:38; Hebrews 5:7*)

Jesus was seen, heard, and touched (*John 20:24-29; 1 John 1:1*)

- He wanted to be us, so we could be like Him!




