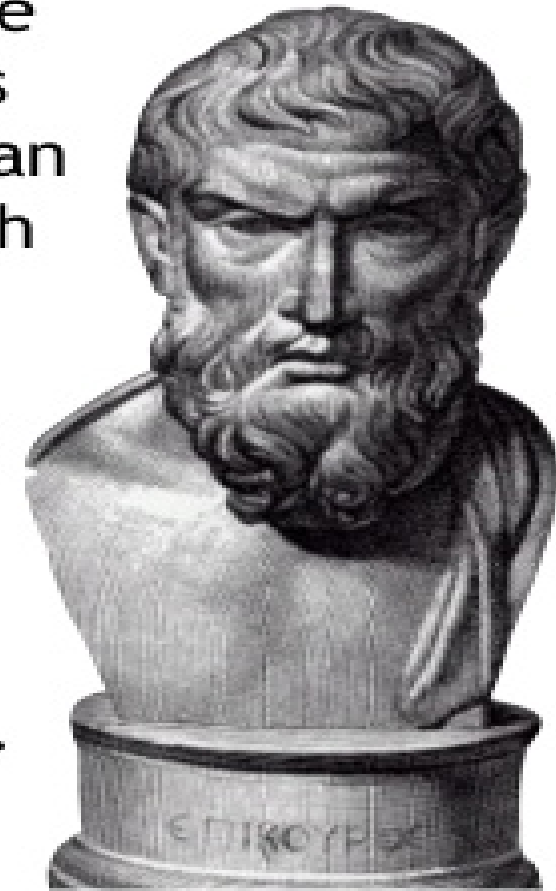
STOICISM

- Founded by Zeno
- Stoic philosophers believe that humans should not pressure desires like power and wealth, because these are dangerous.

- Founded by Epicurus



St. Augustine's Theodicy



His theory is a development of the freewill defence.

i.e. Do not quote the free will defence as independent of the Augustine theodicy as they are based on the same belief in the true autonomy (independence) of human beings.

He based his theory on key Biblical passages:

- Genesis 1-3: the story of Adam and Eve and their 'Fall' in the Garden of Eden.
- Romans 5: 12-20: St Paul describes the Christian belief that Jesus' sacrifice on the Cross wipes out the sin committed by Adam and Eve. Jesus' self sacrifice has made available a boundless gift, the gift of righteousness.

He also based it on two assumptions:

1. Evil is not from God - God's creation was faultless and perfect
2. Evil came from within the world.


