

The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the One and Only, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.





JESUS' TWO NATURES

Jesus is God in flesh (John 1:1, 14). <u>He is fully God and fully man</u> (Col. 2:9), thus, He has two natures: God and man. He is not half God and half man. **He is 100% God** and **100% man**. He never lost His divinity. He existed in the form of God.

Immaterial and Invisible

- Jhn 4:24 "God is spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth."

- ·Yet Jesus "put on" human flesh

WHO IS JESUS?

Jesus was considered and worshipped as God (John 1:1, 18; Philippians 2:9-11; Hebrews 1:6; Revelation 5:13)

WILTEOD Jesus is called Lord (a title given to God alone) (Matthew 3:3, 22:44; Luke 2:11; 1 Corinthians 8:6)

Jesus possesses attributes of God

- Omnipotence (Matthew 8:26–27, 14:19; John 2:1-11)
- Eternality (John 8:58; Revelation 22:13)
- •Omniscience (Mark 2:8; John 1:48, 6:64)
- ·Sovereignty (Mark 2:5-7)
- Immortality (John 2:19)

Jesus was sinless (Hebrews 4:15, 7:26; 1 Peter 1:19:1 John 3:5)

Jesus was tempted (Matthew 4:1-11; Hebrews 4:15)

The divinity and humanity of Jesus are distinct

The divinity and humanity of Jesus are united in the one person of Jesus

Isaiah 9:6; Luke 2:11; John 1:14; Romans 1:3-4:1 Corinthians 2:8; Galatians 4:4-5

Jesus had a Jewish lineage (Matthew 1:1-17; Romans 1:3)

> Jesus was born of a woman (Matthew 1:18-25; Luke 2:1-7)

Jesus had a human body

- He grew (Luke 2:52)
- · He tired (John 4:6)
- He thirsted (John 19:28)
- He hungered (Matthew 4:2)
- · He died (Matthew 27:45-54; Mark FULLY 15:33-41; Luke 23:44-49; John 19:28-30)

Jesus had human emotions (John 11:35; 12:27; Matthew 26:38; Hebrews 5:7)

Jesus was seen, heard, and touched (John 20:24-29:1 John 1:1)

He rose from the dead (Matthew 28:1-10: 1 Corinthians 15:1–8)




Tempted without Sin



Penal Substitutionary Atonement

·Heb 2:14 Therefore, since the children share in flesh and blood, He Himself likewise also partook of the same, so that through death He might destroy the one who has the power of death, that is, the devil,

PENAL SUBSTITUTIONARY ATONEMENT

The atonement is the work Christ accomplished in his life and death to earn salvation for others.

Who Needs Atonement?

Every sinner faces four consequences for his sin: He is now separated from fellowship with God; he is now a slave to sin and Satan; he must die; and he must bear God's wrath. The only way a sinner can avoid these consequences is through atonement.

Atonement [a-bon-mant]: the action of making amends for a wrong or injury




What Was the Cause of the Atonement?

The atonement proceeds from God's love and justice. In love God desired to save those whom he had predestined to belong to him, yet His justice demanded that the penalty due to sinners must be fully paid. Sin's consequences could be overcome only when justice had been satisfied.

JOHN 3:16, ROMANS 3:26, EPHESIANS 1:4-5


