





Interpretation & Application

- The Greek word "apologia" provides the textual foundation for what is called "Apologetics".
- Describes the discipline of providing cogent arguments and reasons for why the Christian belief system should be considered true.
- Peter instructs his readers to "always" (literally "continually") be at the ready to provide an oral defense for why they are a believer in Christ.

Supposing there was no intelligence behind the universe, no creative mind. In that case, nobody designed my brain for the purpose of thinking. It is merely that when the atoms inside my skull happen, for physical or chemical reasons, to arrange themselves in a certain way, this gives me, as a by-product, the sensation I call thought. But, if so, how can I trust my own thinking to be true? It's like upsetting a milk jug and hoping that the way it splashes itself will give you a map of London. But if I can't trust my own thinking, of course I can't trust the arguments leading to Atheism, and therefore have no reason to be an Atheist, or anything else. 




Carl Sagan Center for Research

This is the SETI Institute's research wing, usually referred to as the Carl Sagan Center (CSC). Home to more than 100 scientists, the CSC conducts grant-funded research addressing questions concerning the existence, evolution, and prevalence of life in the universe.

A defining feature of our research is its interdisciplinarity, but it can be broadly segmented into three core divisions:

In the book: *The Truth: God or evolution?* Marshall and Sandra Hall describe an often quoted exchange between Newton and an atheist friend.

Sir Isaac Newton

(4th Jan 1643 - 31st March 1727)

Newton's atheist-scientist friend came by for a visit. Seeing the model, he was naturally intrigued, and proceeded to examine it with undisguised admiration for the high quality of the workmanship. "My, what an exquisite thing this is!" he exclaimed. "Who made it?" Paying little attention to him, Sir Isaac answered, "Nobody." Stopping his inspection, the visitor turned and said, "Evidently you did not understand my question. I asked who made this." Newton, enjoying himself immensely no doubt, replied in a still more serious tone, "Nobody. What you see just happened to assume the form it now has." "You must think I am a fooll"the visitor retorted heatedly, "Of course somebody made it, and he is a genius, and I would like to know who he is!" Newton then spoke to his friend in a polite yet firm way: "This thing is but a puny imitation of a much grander system whose laws you know, and I am not able to convince you that this mere toy is without a designer or maker; yet you profess to believe that the great original from which the design is taken has come into being without either designer or maker! Now tell me by what sort of reasoning do you reach such an incongruous conclusion?"





Flavius Josephus



- "And there arose about this time Jesus, a wise man, if indeed we should call him a man; for he was a doer of marvelous deeds, a teacher of men who receive the truth with pleasure. He won over many Jews and also many Greeks.
- "This man was the Messiah. And when Pilate had condemned him to the cross at the instigation of our own leaders, those who had loved him from the first did not cease. For he appeared to them on the third day alive again, as the holy prophets had predicted and said many other wonderful things about him. And even now the race of Christians, so named after him, has not yet died out."

The External Evidence Test – Josephus

- A disputed passage in Josephus' work mentions Jesus.
- Most scholars do believe that a Christian sympathizer tampered with the text, but they also believe Josephus did write about Jesus
- The accepted rendering is:
- "At this time there was a wise man who was called Jesus. And his conduct was good and was known to be virtuous. Many people among the Jews and other nations became his disciples. Pilate condemned him to be crucified and to die. And those who had become his disciples did not abandon his discipleship. They reported that he had appeared to them three days after his crucifixion and that he was alive; accordingly, he was perhaps the messiah concerning whom the prophets have recounted wonders." - Antiquities 18.3.3


