Old Business

Charles made a motion and Andy seconded for the approving of the security camera upgrade. The company will be here to do the upgrade on September 27, 2021.

Tammy has researched different website options, and Faithlife seems to be the best option. We already use their online giving software, so this just makes sense. It will run about \$200/year which will be saving money compared to what we are currently using. This needs to be done in October. The website will have to be rebuilt, but there is a lot of things on there right now we don't necessarily need on there. The end goal will be to have Rebecca keeping up with it in the office once it is all switched over. We need another delivery of mulch for the playground. This was approved and Rebecca will order the mulch next week.

New Business

The live oak trees by the playground need to be trimmed. Tammy had a company give us a bid, and it was \$900 for both trees, since we are a church they gave us a discount of \$150 so we will pay \$750. This fee is for the trimming, weeding out the dead branches, raising the canopy, and hauling off all the debris. They said that once they are finished, we shouldn't have to mess with the trees for 8-10 years. This was approved and Rebecca will call to schedule a date for completion.

Since Pastor Terry is now the interim pastor, he asked for everyone to please pray for a replacement Sunday School teacher to step in so that he isn't trying to do both Sunday school and the sermon each Sunday.
