MISSION NEWS

AFRICA:Gabe and Olivia Sevigny, VISA missionaries serving at Kibogora Hospital, Rwanda, recently announced that they're expecting— with baby Sevigny arriving in April 2022. Please pray for good health for Olivia and the baby during the pregnancy.

The FMC in Cameroon has opened a nursery and primary school serving 55 students in the village of Mondoni. Due to ongoing conflicts in the country, some students are displaced and cannot attend school. Pray many of the students will have the opportunity to complete the school year successfully. Pray for the encouragement and financial provision for the teachers. Pray God will provide for the needs of pastors in Nigeria who have been training at the Bible school. Many have been unable to attend regularly due to a lack of resources.

ASIA-Praise the Lord for a new 3-week-old church plant in Creative Access Country-NP. Pray for Pastor Prem as he nurtures these believers to become a strong church.
