



Special Missions Presentation by JeDene Reeder Wednesday, October 27th at 7:00 pm



Everyone is invited to come meet and hear JeDene speak about the ministry of Wycliffe Bible Translators, with whom she has served in six countries, conducting reading workshops and designing literacy materials for peoples all across Africa. Today, she's one of only two workers trying to bring

literacy materials and training to the four countries of Côte d'Ivoire, Mali, Burkina Faso and Niger. Her work is changing lives, one person at a time. Literacy training is a crucial component in the work of Bible translation.
