Accepting The Truth

Dr. Paul Chappell

The high priest then asked Jesus of his disciples, and of his doctrine. Jesus answered him, I spake openly to the world; I ever taught in the synagogue, and in the temple, whither the Jews always resort; and in secret have I said nothing. Why askest thou me? ask them which heard me, what I have said unto them: behold, they know what I said.

John 18:19-21

Most of the Pharisees who controlled much of the religious establishment at the time of Christ hated Him. Rather than accepting Him as the Messiah for whom they claimed to be waiting, they refused to heed His message. They were happy with the way things were and saw no reason to upset the power structure they had created. Their selfrighteousness meant that they were unwilling to repent and acknowledge that they needed a Savior. The problem was not that they had not heard the truth. Jesus proclaimed it publicly again and again. The problem was that they would not heed the truth.

The Lord does not allow us to come to Him on our own terms. We must accept salvation through Iesus alone, or we will never receive it. It is imperative that we heed the message rather than try to find alternative ways through which we can gain acceptance in His sight. So many people today are willing to believe and do almost
